### Child Development Infant/Toddler Head Teacher

- Period of Employment** Part time (25 hours/week, mornings) teaching position at the Early Childhood Laboratory in the Center for Child & Family Studies (CCFS) for 2009-2010 nine-month academic year. Position begins on September 14, 2009 with a two week, full-time orientation period. Possibility of annual contract renewal.
- Salary** The salary is \$19,126 for the nine-month academic year. Core university benefits are provided.
- Qualifications** Applicant must have a minimum of a bachelor's degree in early childhood education or child development, including infant development, by June 2009, with teaching experience in a high-quality early care and education program. Experience in research and theory-based lab school infant/toddler program is preferred.
- Duties** Assist the Program Coordinator in designing, implementing, and assessing a developmentally appropriate program for infants or toddlers in keeping with CCFS program philosophy; help supervise and model best practices for UC Davis students working in the program for academic credit; function as the lead teacher responsible for one classroom of 10-12 children; assist faculty and students in using CCFS for research projects. The Child Development Head Teacher will have opportunities for professional growth.
